In this regard, the Permanent Mission of India would like to state that Mr. S. Bhuvaneshwaran was engaged in the real estate business. Following detailed investigations by concerned police authorities, it was found that Mr. Syed Ibrahim, a business rival of the victim, conspired with nine others and murdered Mr. Bhuvaneshwaran on 10 January 2012. Of the 10 accused, 5 were arrested and remanded to judicial custody and the remaining 5 accused had surrendered in different Magistrate Courts. All the 10 accused have been charge sheeted on completion of investigation. The case is pending trial in the Court of Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore in the State of Tamil Nadu. Regular police beats are being posted to cater to the safety and security of the family members of the deceased.

The Permanent Mission of India requests that the response of the Government of India be presented in full to the Special Rapporteurs.
