According to the Judiciary's High Council for Human Rights:

According to information received from the province of Hormozgan's department of justice, the body of an unknown person was found in an automobile, shot in the head.

After identical investigations and medical examinations, it became known that the body belonged to Mr. Ataollah Rezvani which was transmitted to the forensics for further investigation. Therefore, a file was opened in the second branch of general and revolutionary prosecutor's office in the city of Bandar- Abbas.

By the way, it is worthy to mention, according to the existing evidences, that this event was more similar to a suicide, than a murder.
