According to information received from the Justice Department of Fars province, Mr. Kaveh Nouri was tried by the third branch of Revolutionary Court in Shiraz on charges of:

- 1- Propaganda against the Islamic Republic of Iran
- 2- Membership in opposition (terrorist) groups with the aim of disturbing national security
- 3- Insulting the state officials, specially the Supreme Leader

After hearing of the defense provided by Mr. Nouri and his lawyer Mr. Fariborz Yekdollahi, the court sentenced him to one year in prison for the first charge, 34 months in prison for the second charge and six month in prison for the third one. The issued verdict was appealed by the condemned person and his lawyer. The Appeal Court branch 16 in Fars province, after reconsiddering the case, has rejected the appeal and affirmed the verdict.

Mr. Salehoddin Marandi was arrested on charges of disturbing public order and participating in illegal gathering.

The verdict yet to be issued and the accused is still in prison due to his failure to introduce a guaranteeing person to be released on trial.
