My dear Special Procedures,

I have the honour to refer to your letter No.AL G/SO 214 (53-24) G/SO 214 (89-15) dated 2 May 2012 regarding the allegations of rape of Ms. Sonia Rani, by her step-father.

2. We are in receipt of the following information :

According to the relevant authorities, a case was registered against the accused Mohammad Ramzan on 8 April 2012. The accused was arrested and a physical remand was obtained from the concerned court of law. The accused was subsequently produced in the court of learned Sessions of Judge, Hafizabad. During the hearing, Ms. Sonia Rani submitted an affidavit in which she categorically exonerated the accused of the allegations filed by her. She further stated in her affidavit that the case had been registered due to suspicion and misunderstanding. On 16 April 2012, the court accepted the bail application of Mohammad Ramzan and he was released on bail from jail. The case is pending trial.
