With reference to the communication number IRN 20/2014 dated 3 October 2014, on the situation of [REDACTED] the following information has been provided by the "High Council for Human Rights of the Judiciary of the I.R. of Iran ":

[REDACTED] was arrested and prosecuted on charges of espionage and assembling and complicity against national security.

After exhausting due process and hearings, he has been sentenced to 11 years of imprisonment for the charges committed. The issued verdict was appealed by the defendant. Hence Tehran province Appeal Court reviewed the case and reaffirmed the verdict except the charge of assembling and complicity against national security, as the result of which the verdict reduced to 8 years imprisonment.

It should be noted that he has access to adequate medical care and enjoys all prison's facilities like other prisoners during his imprisonment period.
