
The Permanent Mission of the Republic of The Sudan to the United Nations Office and other International Organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR – Division of Special Procedures of the Human Rights Council), and with reference to the latter's letter Ref: UA G/SO 218/2 G/SO 217/16/SO 214 (67-17) Assembly & Association (2010-1) G/SO 214 (107-9) G/SO 214 (53-24) SDN 3/2014, dated 26th May 2014, has the honour to confirm its commitment to cooperate with the Special Procedures of the Human Rights Council.

As the name of the said person is a common name in The Sudan, the Permanent Mission of the Republic of The Sudan would like to request specific necessary information in order to properly convey the case to the respective authorities, these information are:

1. The national serial number or the passport number of Mr. Abdelrahman.
2. The University in which Mr. Abdelrahman is registered as a student, and the number and details of his student identity card.
3. The Street address of Mr. Abdelrahman's family home in Khartoum that alleged to have been closely under surveillance by "approximately" 10 armed security agents following the memorial event in one of the campuses of the University of Khartoum on 11th March 2014.
4. The national serial number or the passport number of his brother whom alleged to be attacked.
5. The local remedies that Mr. Abdelrahman sought prior to presenting the alleged mentioned violations of his human rights, and whether or not Mr. Abdelrahman and/or his family exhausted the available local remedies before presenting his case before the Special Procedures of the Human Rights Council.

The Mission would like to stress the importance of the aforementioned requested information for the respective authorities to investigate the case of Mr. Abdelrahman, and expects to receive those information at the earliest possible convenience.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of The Sudan avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights the assurances of its highest consideration.
