According to the information received from the Justice Department of western Azerbaijan province, Mr. Habibollah Golparipour has been arrested and prosecuted on charges of:

1. Involvement in Terrorist operations
2. Membership in and cooperation with the Pejak terrorist group.

After hearing process, the revolutionary court in Mahabad city found him guilty and sentenced him to death. The verdict was appealed by the condemned person and his lawyers Mr. Khalil Bahramian and Mr. Seyyed Ehsan Mojtabavi. Subsequently, the Supreme Court has considered once again the case and refused the appeal and reconfirmed the verdict. Afterward, the condemned person and his lawyers asked for pardon from the Amnesty Commission, but according to the type and seriousness of the charges, his pardon request has not been agreed and finally, the verdict was executed on 26/10/2013.
