With regard to the situation of Ms. Razieh Ebrahimi, the following information has been provided by the "High Council for Human Rights of the Judiciary of the I.R. of Iran":

Ms. Razieh Ebrahimi was arrested and prosecuted by the criminal court of Khuzestan province on charge of intentional killing of her husband. After exhausting legal proceeding and hearing the defenses of Ms. Ebrahimi and her lawyer (Mr. Diniary), the court convicted her to Qesas (Retribution-in-kind). The issued verdict was appealed by the defendant and her lawyer. The Appeal Court, after reconsidering the case, has rejected the appeal and reaffirmed the verdict.

Subsequently, the verdict was appealed for the second time before the Supreme Court which resulted in issuance of the permit by the Supreme Court for retrial the case in another court at the same judicial level. Therefore the case is under reconsideration and the final verdict yet to be issued.
