My dear Special Procedures,

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your communication No.OL Pak 4/2015 dated 3 June 2015.

2. We have conveyed your communication to the concerned quarters in Pakistan in order to get the factual details about the case.

3. Meanwhile, I would like to underscore that as highlighted in your afore-referred correspondence, the alleged victim being of Moroccan origin was transferred back to Morocco in May 2002 in accordance with our established policy. All foreigners suspected of being involved in terrorist activities abroad are routinely handed back to the country of their origin with the understanding that the country concerned would further pursue the investigations and take legal action in accordance with its domestic laws.

4. Nevertheless, we will revert to you once the details of the investigation carried out by our authorities in this regard are received.
