"According to the General Department of Justice of Kurdistan Province, Mr. Himan Uraminejad was charged with murder of Mr. Pouya Abolghasemi and following exhaustion of all the relevant legal procedures and domestic remedies, and on the basis of verdict No. 0040, dated 11.08.2012 of the Penal Court of Kurdistan Province, was sentenced to retribution (Qisas Nafs). The verdict was also reinstated by the State Supreme Court, but upon the consent of the owners of the blood on 22.12.2016, execution of the verdict was cancelled."
