Situation of Mr. Reza KARIMI

The following information has been provided by the High Council for Human Rights of the Judiciary of the Islamic Republic of Iran:

"According to the latest information provided by the Department of Justice of Alborz Province, was arrested on the basis of the of the judicial warrant on the charge of murder of the Late by inflicting wounds, by knife, on the body of his victim. He was sentenced to Qisas (retribution in kind). The decision was appealed by his lawyers and for two times. Upon exhaustion of legal remedies in Branch 3 of the High Court, the sentence was upheld. In a separate case, Mr. Karimi was charged and convicted with holding 925 grams of condensed heroin, for which he was sentenced to death on 23 October, 2011.

Since 21.01.2015, He has been in RajaeiShahr prison, receiving all required needs (including medical care and access to phone), similar to any other prisoner. He has also been regularly met by his sister and mother. He was dispatched to out of hospital, on the prescription of the prison physician. It is noteworthy that Mr. Karimi has committed illegal actions while in prison including fights with inmates, hiding mobile phone in his cell.
