Situation of four individuals

The following information has been provided by the High Council for Human Rights of the Judiciary of the Islamic Republic of Iran:

"According to the information provided by the General Justice Department of Tehran Province,

- 1. **Mr. Ehsan Mazanderani** was charged with assembly and collusion with the intension of committing crime. He was sentenced to two years of imprisonment. His term of imprisonment shall terminate on 31st October, 2017. He enjoys the right of meeting his family and access to telephone.
- 2. Mr. **Morad Saghafi** was issued with the bill of indictment and is presently in detention in Evin Prison. He enjoys the right of meeting his family and access to telephone.
- 3. Mr. **Ali Ahmadnia Shalmani** is passing his term of imprisonment in Evin Prison. He enjoys the right of meeting his family and access to telephone.
- 4. Ms. **Tahereh Riyahi** is temporarily in detention in Evin Prison upon the bill of indictment issued by the Culture and Media Prosecutor's Office. She has received visits and phone calls from her family.
