Situation of Mr. Sabri HASSANPOUR

The following information has been provided by the High Council for Human Rights of the Islamic Republic of Iran :

“According to the report received from the General Department of Justice of Tehran Province, Mr. Sabri Hassanpour, son of Mohammad Ali, is charged with assembly and collusion against internal and external security, propaganda against the State, agitation of public opinion through cyberspace and internet, membership in hostile terrorist groups (MKO and Cherek Fadayi Khalgh) and insult against the Late Imam Khomeini.

His file and bill of indictment was sent to the court and the pertinent court met on 12 Nov. 2016 at the presence of his defence attorney, Mr. Ali Shabanzadeh. There is not yet a judgment issued on the case.

Mr. Hassanpour has been under full supervision of the prison clinic and on confirmation of the Evin prison doctors, he was dispatched to hospital for surgery. He has been receiving regular visits from members of his family and there is no limit on his access to telephone.”
