Situation of Ms. Rahele RAHIMPOUR(Rahemipour)

The following response is provided by the High Council of Human Rights of the Judiciary of the Islamic Republic of Iran

"According to the existing information, Ms. Raheleh Rahimpour (Rahemipour) raised fabricated allegations, supported by the MKO terrorist group, on disappearing of her nephew in prison several years ago. In absence of any evidence and proof, he did not refer to judicial authorities and beside publicizing, organized protest assemblies. Due to her illegal acts, she was arrested and upon completion of investigations and the due process of law as well as hearing of her defence and enjoyment of a lawyer, she was annoticted with propagation activity against the State and sentenced to one year of discretionary imprisonment (Taziri imprisonment), by Branch 15 of TEHRAN Court.
