Following my letter, no 3238 of 8 December 2020, I would like to present the latest developments related to the amendment to the Law on National Education no. 1/2011.

On 16 December 2020, the Constitutional Court admitted the President's claim of unconstitutionality of the amendment forbidding references to gender identity in educational institutions. This evolution confirms once again that internal mechanisms are functioning and ensure the full protection of human rights and the respect of the international engagements of Romania in the field of fundamental rights.
