**Regarding Mr. Shokrollah Jebelli**

The aforesaid has been sentenced to four years and six months in jail and 4,000,000,000 IRR in cash fine. Furthermore, the convict is sentenced to restituting the said amount to the claimant. Therefore, allegations of imprisonment on financial grounds and insolvency are absolutely false. It is hereby noted that the convict has hitherto failed to reimburse the plaintiff.

In response to allegations concerning the lack of medical care and treatment, it is hereby announced that the abovenamed has on multiple occasions been transferred to hospitals situated outside prison for treatment. The aforementioned was examined by medical examiners to decide about capacity to serve time because of old age, physical weakness and movement disorders. To that effect, a demand has been filed for his

lease under electronic monitoring, which the Council is examining. The aforesaid also enjoys access to telephone without let or hindrance.
