ADDITIONAL OBSERVATIONS FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF BRAZIL REGARDING LETTER OL BRA 13/2021 (10/27/2021)

I refer to the preliminary reply sent by the Brazilian government, on January 21, with respect to the letter AL BRA 13/2021, referring to the situation of human rights defenders Anacleta Pires da Silva, Joércio Pires da Silva and Elias Belfort Pires. In addition to this reply, I have the honor to convey the following additional elements.

3. The 3rd Prosecutor's Office of the District of Itapecuru Mirim notes that there is no criminal proceeding against the human rights defenders mentioned in the letter AL BRA 13/2021. There was, though, a Circumstancial Term of Occurrence (TCO), held at the Police Station of Itapecuru-Mirim according to Mr. Bartolomeu Vieira de Araújo's note.
