The Russian Federation, having studied the above joint enquiry, would like to draw attention to the fact that information on the merits of the situation of I. B. Danilovich was forwarded in a timely manner to the United Nations Human Rights Council special procedures in response to request G/SO 217/1 Russian Federation of 9 May 2022, by note No. 2780 of 1 July 2022 from the Permanent Mission of the Russian Federation to the United Nations Office and Other International Organizations in Geneva.

The case of I. B. Danilovich remains the subject of verifications and legal proceedings under the domestic law of the Russian Federation.

The Constitution (article 120) and the legislation on the judicial system of the Russian Federation prohibit any non-procedural influencing of the judiciary.
