I would like to tender a brief submission with respect to allegations made in the attached document with reference to " Ministry of Health abruptly and without publicly stated reason, decided on the closure of the School of Nursing in Linden, depriving the young Afro Guyanese who were already admitted to the School of Educational and future employment opportunities" - Page 3.

The office of Nursing and Midwifery can safely attest that the Charles Rosa school of Nursing is currently in effect and of recent (February, 2023) had a total 27 Registered Nurses who were successful at the Professional Nursing program, graduated and was successfully assigned to various institutions within the country. Additionally, for the past three years, dated 2020 to present the Office of Nursing and Midwifery has assigned through training a total of 154 nursing personnel which provides evidence of the existence of the Charles Rosa School of Nursing.

NB: The Charles Rosa School of Nursing also facilitates training for young, vibrant individuals of various ethnicities from regions 1, 7,8 and 9 of which after completion of their programmes, they are dispatched to their respective regions for work.
