The Permanent Mission of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to the United Nations Office and Other International Organizations at Geneva presents its compliments to the Office of the Special Procedures Branch (OHCHR), and in relation to the press statement released on October 16, 2023 from the Special Rapporteur on extrajudicial, summary or arbitrary executions, in regard of communication reference; UA SAU 04/2023, we would like to point out the following;

First: the Kingdom replied to the aforementioned communication within the time frame, letter no.413/374 dated August 31, 2023.

Second: the permanent mission would highly appreciate receiving detailed clarification on the reason for the absence of reference and consideration to the Kingdom's reply.

Third: The information contained in the statement is inaccurate and included false allegations, the Kingdom previously submitted responses that [REDACTED] was an adult and over the age of (18) years old at the time he committed the crimes for which he was convicted for.

In that regard, the Permanente Mission express the most profound regret and disappointment, that the special procedures branch neglected the reply it received from the Kingdom and has failed to take its content thoroughly into account.

The Permanent Mission of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Office of the Special Procedures Branch, the assurance of its highest Consideration.
