Receipt is hereby acknowledged of communication UA/CHN/11/2024 sent by a special procedure of the United Nations Human Rights Council. The Chinese Government wishes to reply as follows:

██████████ was detained on 18 June 2004 on suspicion of drug smuggling and formally arrested on 10 August 2004. On 22 March 2005, ██████████ ██████████ Court held public proceedings and handed down a criminal decision on 20 April 2005. ██████████ was sentenced to death for drug smuggling, with a 2 year reprieve, and with the confiscation of all personal property. After sentencing, ██████████ refused to accept the verdict and appealed against it. On 7 July 2005, ██████████ ██████████ Court issued a criminal decision rejecting the appeal and upholding the original decision. At the same time, it confirmed the sentence. On 11 August 2005, ██████████ entered ██████████ Women's Prison to serve her sentence. After six sentence reductions, ██████████ was released from prison on 12 May 2024 having served her sentence.
