The Permanent Mission of India has the honour to submit that Ms. Suneeta Pottam was accused in 13 cases and was absconding after a warrant was issued against her by the Court. Later she was found and arrested as per due process by the police, and thereafter produced before the Court, in line with legal procedure. This may kindly be brought to the attention of the Special Rapporteurs.
