
We refer to the Joint Communication, Ref. AL OTH 87/2025, dated July 2, 2025 from the Special Procedures of the Office of United Nations High Commissioner's for Human Rights. Exxon Mobil Corporation ("ExxonMobil") received the letter from this office on August 27, 2025, and respectfully provides the following comments.

ExxonMobil confirms that the divestment of its affiliate, Mobil Producing Nigeria Unlimited (MPN), to Seplat Energy was completed after obtaining all necessary regulatory approvals from the Nigerian authorities following their due diligence process.

It is our policy to comply with all applicable environmental laws and regulations and conduct business in a manner that is compatible with the balanced environmental and economic needs of the communities in which we operate.

ExxonMobil continues to maintain a significant deepwater presence in Nigeria. We value our relationships with the people and government of Nigeria, and we will continue to work to manage our environmental and social impacts, safeguard the health of our employees and the public, and uphold respect for human rights in our operations.
