The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Indonesia to the United Nations, the World Trade Organization, and other International Organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights and has the honor to acknowledge receipt of Joint Communication No. AL IDN 2/2026 dated 5 March 2026.

In this regard, the Permanent Mission wishes to inform the Office that the trial concerning the three individuals referenced in the Communication was concluded on 6 March 2026. The competent court found the individuals **not guilty** and **acquitted** them of all charges. Furthermore, the Coordinating Minister for Law, Human Rights, Immigration and Correctional Institutions also has encouraged the Attorney General **not to challenge the decision in a higher court**. This outcome reflects the proper functioning of Indonesia's judicial system, which operates independently and free from external influence, including from the Communication that was transmitted to the Permanent Mission around the same period of when the court rendered its decision.

In light of the above, it would be grateful if the Office could transmit the aforementioned information to the relevant Special Procedures for their further consideration. While underlining Indonesia's continued commitment to cooperating with the United Nations Human Rights Council's mechanisms and mandates, the Permanent Mission kindly seeks a favourable consideration of the Special Procedures to refrain from any publication or press release prior to the submission of the Government's response.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Indonesia to the United Nations, the World Trade Organization, and Other International Organizations in Geneva, avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights, the assurances of its highest consideration.
